Statement of Medical Necessity

I am writing to confirm that Margaret Holloway is under my care for a diagnosis of Common Variable Immunodeficiency (ICD-10: D83.9). She has documented hypogammaglobulinemia with recurrent serious infections requiring immunoglobulin replacement therapy.

Intravenous immunoglobulin (IVIG) therapy with Octagam 10% at a dose of 40g administered every 4 weeks is medically necessary to maintain adequate IgG levels and prevent life-threatening infections. This treatment is consistent with current clinical guidelines for the management of CVID.

Without ongoing IVIG therapy, this patient is at significant risk of serious bacterial infections, hospitalisation, and long-term complications. Continuation of this treatment is essential to her health and wellbeing.
